<b>Free play</b>	Say "Play, please" to peer when entering an activity	Take toy from peer when offered a turn	Say "hi" to peer when entering an activity	Say "Turn, please" to peer
<b>Snack</b>		Take juice pitcher from peer when offered	Say "hi" to peer when sitting down to snack	Say "Juice/snack, please"
<b>Small group</b>		Painting with cars—take car from peer	Say "Hi" to peer when sitting down to paint with cars	Painting with cars—Say "Car/turn, please"
<b>Outside</b>	Say "Play, please" in sandbox	Take shovel from peer in sandbox	Say "hi" to peer when going to play in the sandbox	Say "Shovel/bucket, please" in sandbox
<b>Large group</b>		Take instrument basket from peer during music time		Say "Turn, please" to peer at music time to request instrument basket
<b>Departure</b>			Say "Bye" to peer
